My name is Gerrit H. Enigenburg, and I am compiling the Enigenburg Family Ancestry. I received a picture card from my Neice, Mrs. D. Lucier who had been in Holland and came in contact with you. I am enclosing copies of the Jon Family History and I find only my Grandfather Gerrit Enigenburg named. In looking through the De Jong or De Young Family book, I came across Joris Hark Enigenburg and a daughter Geertje, also wife of Joris - Trijntje Bowman. Will send these sheets to you. Numbers - 1-2-3-4-5-6. Can or will you please get in contact with any information on the earlier families. All I have is on page 1. On page 4 and 5, I got those from De Young History. Would like to know how many Enigenburgs I can file in my records and also dates & places. Am not doing this for money, but as I am 73 yrs. old and not working at the Carpenter trade any more, I decided to use up some of my time in recording our family. Any help that you can give, or get me in touch with somebody who can collect this information will be greatly appreciated. Would like any pictures available too, of our ancestors. This is very interesting work, and I have enjoyed getting information

out of the Ton Family Book.

I have gotten all of the Enigentburgs living & dead in the United States, and want to form a list for the heads of each Family. Please see what can be done and try to have them in order from oldest and down the line. Have no record of Genit Enigentburgs back ground at all. How many Brothers or Sisters? When born, Where, Marriages, Children, Deaths. I know this is asking a lot from you, but I must start somewhere and your card was the first indication I could find. Could I get in touch with the Dutch Consulate? Would that be necessary?

We held Ton Family Picnics for about 56 years and then stopped. Old age, Lack of Interest in younger ones and the books were closed and put in Pullman Public Library Archives. So some of us Enigentburgs would like to have Enigentburg Reunions, and that is how I started on our Ancestors.
